

Looking Back

November 6, 1977 Missouri Turkey Trot, dual XC meet with St. Louis Track Club. These dual XC events with SLTC were great events--good competition, great food afterwards with the site alternating each year between Columbia and St. Louis. Awards were frozen chickens and turkeys. We were reluctant to call it a "Chicken Trot." Scoring was on a mass basis, the number of scorers equal to the fewest number of runners in an age group on one of the teams. For example, on this date each team scored 16 runners in age group sub-39. CTC won 238-290 with Tim McMullen leading the way with 15:01 over 3 miles on the Gustin course. He was followed by Dennis Hinkamp with 15:08 and Charlie Evans with 15:37. In age 40+ it was CTC 42 & SLTC 63, each scoring 7. Ben Londeree was the winner there with 16:25. For the women, SLTC, scoring 4, swept CTC 10-26. Glenna Moe, 23:39, led the CTC women. There was a total of 108 runners.

25 years ago Wesley Paul and Mark Landrum represented CTC in the New York City Marathon, the 2nd annual. Mark had a 2:39:34 while Wesley, at age 8, stunned the staid New Yorkers with a scintillating 3:00:31, a world age 8 record which still stands. The New York Times said Wesley, after the finish, was in better shape than was the winner Bill Rodgers. But then Rodgers had done his run in a fine 2:11+.

Board members Linda LaFontaine, Joe Duncan, Dick Hessler, and Mark Volek were reelected.

The 2003 race schedule was approved.

Tom Allen, Treasurer, gave his report that indicated almost enough money in a CD to fund the CTC Marks Scholarship in perpetuity. Tom's report is appended.

President Dick Hessler reported that the 2002 Summer Youth Program had 286 participants ages 4-16, plus 20 three-year old children who ran the 50-meter dash. The Colts had a very successful Show Me State Games and cross country season, with the boys winning the championship race held at the new Stephens lake park. The inaugural Rock Bridge Revenge was a great success and CTC will include the race on our brochure. Also, CTC will have a kids' mile run in conjunction with the St. Patrick's Day Race. CTC has asked Mayor Hindman to support the mile and he has agreed. We will call it the Mayor's Mile for Kids and we hope to get a banner made through the Mayor's office. CTC will purchase traffic safety vests and stop signs. Finally, we will not sell the rights to the Heart of America Marathon.

Discussion from the floor led us to commit to work extra hard next year on getting more youth involved in running. We will work with middle and elementary school staff to stimulate participation in the St. Pat's race and our cross-country series.



Seventeen hardy runners had a 25 degree temperature and slight wind for the 8:30 a.m. start. The cheese prizes would go to the runners who came closest to their estimated time. No watches allowed. The course is completely flat with 8 of the 10 miles on asphalt and 2 miles on the MKT trail. The leaders were paced for the first 5 miles by a local Beagle dog who eventually waited at the finish line to greet the runners as they crossed. Joe Duncan won the big cheese award for being just 17 seconds off his predicted time. Neil Warner was 2nd with a 35 second discrepancy, and Dave Coogan was 3rd with a 39 second gap. The sauer-kraut went to Marcena Tomicki. This was the first 10 mile road race for Ryan Deason who ran 1:16.58 which was good enough for 4th place overall. A very special thanks to Randy Gay and Scott Dressel for timing and scoring.
