next door to them in Michigan, and while I wasn't much of a runner when I lived close to them, I took notice of their dedication to running at an early age. Ernie Moosa, Angela Passanise, Dave Coogan, and Pam Lewandowski (as well as many others) have served as training partners, motivators and encouragers.

**PERSONAL INFO AND INTERESTS:** I like running on the MKT trail and watch for birds and listen for frogs. I am beginning to get interested in triathlons, and have begun to swim and cycle. I also like to write creatively, read, and brew beer.

From the January 1978 CTC newsletter:


