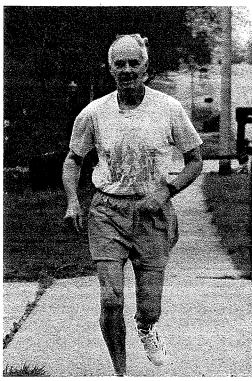

Amina And Alexa Shelton Shine At Annual MU All-Comers Meet

CTC members Amina and Alexa Shelton competed in a combined total of 7 events on Feb. 19 and recorded 7 personal- indoor bests at the 21st Annual MU All-Comers Meet at Hearnes Center. Amina, 11, competing for the first time in the high jump took 1st place with a jump of 3' 8 1/2" in the 14 and under age division. She also took 2nd in the long jump with a jump of 13' 5", bettering her previous best of 13' 2 1/2" she did at last year's AAU National Indoor meet that was the best-ever for 10 and under girls and good enough for the bronze in the 11 and 12 age group. She also took 4th in the 60 meter dash with a MEET personal best 9.11 (I've timed her in 8.9 in practice). Finally, she took 6th in the 200 meter dash in 31.00. Alexa, 8, also competing in the 14 and under division took 5th in the long jump with a jump of 9' 4". She took 19th in the 60 meters in 10.56 and also 19th in the 200 meters in 39.52
