was the closeness of Hendricks victory-his habit is to go a sensible even pace with a 2nd half faster than the first. So it went this time except that when he went by Dan Kaprowicz after Easley Hill and Karl Naylor after 15 miles, he thought he had the lead. He was somewhat dismayed to learn that Rosales was over $3\frac{1}{2}$ minutes ahead of him. Hendricks gradually closed the gap, although he didn't catch sight of Rosales until he approached the hill at 24 miles. From that point on he zeroed in on Rosales, finally catching him on College Ave, not far from Broadway. The winning margin of 19 seconds made this the closest finish ever.

Dick Hessler headed the CTC contingent turning in the best time for this course for a CTC member. Londeree, Kilburn, Duncan, Leuthold and Busen also got personal bests. Dean Neal and Rex Frazer were in their first Marathons as was Charles Geiss--all of them doing quite well the first time out. Augie Hirt is no doubt one of the few people anywhere who has run a marathon in less than 3 hours (last year) and walked one in less than 4 hours (this year). MVAAU medals went to

Rosales, Conaway and Kacprowicz.
