An account of the "Run for the Third" from the Sedalia paper:

A Fayetteville, Ark., man made a nice addition to his holiday vacation

here Saturday morning.

Ron Troutman, a 29-year-old architect, defeated 89 area runners in the fourth annual 10,000-meter Run for the Third road race, sponsored by the Third National Bank in cooperation with the Sedalia Runners Club. Troutman was in town visiting his father, H.P. Troutman, assistant director of the State Fair.

Troutman easily outdistanced the field in 30-degree temperatures, finishing more than a half-minute ahead of runnerup Jeff Mittelhauser of Sedalia with a winning time of 32:51.7. Troutman said his best time over the distance is more than a minute faster at 31:33.

"The course was really just ght," Troutman said. "It was fast right,"

and had just the right amount of rolling hills:

"But each end of the course had a let of snow and it really hurt the times. The final lap lost each runner at least 30 seconds off their time.

The race began near the corner of Liberty Park Boulevard and Highway 65, headed to the Broderick and Bascomb Rope Co., Route 3, north of town and returned to the boulevard, finishing with a one-lap run around the Jennie Jaynes Stadium track.

Milene Mittelhauser of Sedalia was the top woman finisher in the group, completing the course in 39:47.9.

She and Troutman received trophies for their efforts. Winners in each age category received walnut plaques with medals to the second and third finishers in each group.


