JON HERBERT SUCCESSFULLY DEFENDS TITLE, LIZ BULMAN SHATTERS WOMEN'S RECORD WITH 3:00:07, BILL FOX POSTS 2nd BEST AGE 40+ MARK HEART OF AMERICA MARATHON October 10, 1982

Herbert pressed the issue from the outset, building a sizable lead even in the very first mile; developing almost a 150 yard advantage by mile two and steadily increasing the margin until about the 23 mile mark. From that point on it was a struggle for Jon, apparently feeling the effects of five previous marathons this year, including Pike's Peak the middle of August. Bob 0°Connell had moved into second place at 5 miles or so and at that 23 mile point he was a good five minutes out of first. But he was moving at a solid sub 6:00 pace and Herbert was beginning to slow. Jon slowed markedly over the last mile and it became a matter of his hanging on. He did and 0°Connell ran out of time, although he covered the last 5 miles, 385 yards in 30:48 while Herbert covered the same distance in 33:45. 0°Connell, by the way, is in Colorado Springs for a year, so he is getting some workouts at altitude. He, too, had problems in this race-problems with stomach distress which required a pit stop or two. Robert Steven Cline was comfortably in third most of the race so that for the second year in a row the first three went Herbert, 0°Connell and Cline. That gives Cline a second, two thirds and a fifth over the last four years.

LIZ BULMAN shattered the women's record with a magnificent 3:00:07 well under the 3:07:17 posted by Wendy Thomas last year. Thomas was on hand to see her record broken (and to see husband Steve and brother Joe Meyer run), but was unable to contest the women's title since she is some eight months pregnant. Next year may see the first sub 3:00 by a woman.

BILL FOX, a new 40 year old, ran the second fastest race by one so old, beating Dick Hesler's former second fastest mark by 33 seconds. The fastest time ever recorded by a 40+ runner is the remarkable 2:36:07 set by Roger Rouiller in 1979. There's an interesting situation with these 40 year olds. Last year Hessler had just turned 40 and set his mark. This time Fox just turns 40 and lowers that mark. Next year Lou Fritz turns 40. Will he take the #2.time down another notch? Hessler, Fox and Fritz have battled each other for several years in H of A and now they will be doing it as 40 year olds. Speaking of Fritz, he was back for the 18th year in a row and he had his usual fine performance and strong finish, with his second half 3:17 faster than the first half. And, it is much more difficult to turn that second half faster than the first with the change in the way the course is run. It's more difficult because Easley Hill comes two miles into the second half instead of at the end of the first half. A couple of other runners who stormed over the last half were Frank Curotto and Norm Stebbins. In fact, Curotto ran the second half faster than anybody: 1:18:33, one second faster than O'Connell, except for Cline who covered it in 1:17:52. Stebbins was five minutes faster over that last half.

Joe Marks gave a testimonal for two months of rest and a 15 day crash program. Marks had written off H of A because of his foot injury and lack of running for two months. However, with 15 days to go he began testing himself, found that he was ok, so began his 15 day rush to the start of H of A. He obviously did quite well, almost climbing up the back of Dick Hessler.

DAN HOXWORTH won the Dave Schulte Award for Improved Performance with his 2:42:04 compared with the 3:26:27 he had in 1977 when he was 18 years old. Dan's improvement amounted to 295 points based on the Gardner-Purdy tables and a whopping 21:50%. Mike Teel had a 22:23% improvement, but the nod went to Hoxworth because Teel's improvement was only 267 G-P points.

Howard Calkin, the doctor from Oregon, Mo. became the oldest H of A finisher at age 71.

The weather was great except for the strong wind against the runners for most of the first 9 miles. Never before had the temperature been below 50--only twice before was it in the low 50's, '72 & '74, on a Labor Day. But, and this was a problem, and probably prevented faster times, never before had the wind been so strong over the first few miles. Labor Day, historically has been pretty calm.
