

ELAPSED TIME CATEGORY: There will be the following Elapsed Time Divisions:

RUNNERS - Male: (1) Age 15 and under; (2) Age 16-29; (3) Age 30-39; (4) Age 40-49; (5) Age 50-59;

(6) Age 60 and over. Female: (1) Age 15 and under; (2) Age 16-34; (3) Age 35 and over.

WALKERS: Open only.

Points will be accumulated during the season with each eligible competitor getting points per race Points will be accumulated during the season with each eligible competitor gets in the last finisher gets. There are 8 eligible equal to the number of eligible competitors (s)he beats, plus one. Example: There are 8 eligible runners in a race. The first finisher of those 8 gets 8 points, the last finisher gets I point. In addition, runners in a race. The first finisher of those 8 gets 8 points, the last finisher gets I point. In addition, runners in a race. It is given as follows: One must compete maximum of 50 points. At the end of the season, awards will be given as follows: One must compete maximum of 50 points. At the end of the season, awards will be given in each division (if in at least 5 events to be eligible for an award. At least one award will be given in each division will receive an award up to a maximum of 6 awards. Thereafter, awards will be given at a 1-5 division will receive an award up to a maximum of 10 awards in any one division. EVERY race ratio (rounded to the nearest 5), with a maximum of 10 awards in any one division. EVERY race (except the Regional Hospital Race, Human Race IX, and the Channel 8K Race) will count as an Elapsed Time event; however, only one's best 18 events (10 for walkers) will count. This gives 2 "free" events.



Run Packets

There will be no other pre-run procedure; simply be at the starting line no later than 1:45 p.m.

Times

Run times will be recorded with electronic chronomix timers. Split timing will be called at each mile marker. A two-sided digital clock will precede the runners and will be on display at the finish line.

Parking

Parking is available at the Boone Clinic parking lots on the west side of Keene Street, across the street from Columbia Regional Hospital.

Restrooms

Facilities will be provided outside the hospital adjacent to the registration area.

Weather

The run will be held regardless of weather conditions.

Publication of Results

Runners' names, place, ages, and times will be published in the Columbia Daily Tribune during the week following the run.

Certified Course

Certified 5-mile road course. Start on Portland Street east of Columbia Regional Hospital, south on Portland past Lansing Avenue to Albany Drive. South on Albany Drive to St. Charles Road, east and north on St. Charles Road to I-70 Drive S.E., then proceed west. Head south on Keene Street to east on Berrywood to finish. Splits will be read at each mile mark.

Run Headquarters

Proceed from the parking area due east to Lansing Avenue. Cross the hospital employee parking lot to the north and follow signs to the rear (east side) of the hospital. PLEASE DO NOT USE THE FRONT ENTRANCE OF THE HOSPITAL.

Finish Line Procedure

Be sure to enter your appropriate chute according to sex. Stay in the male or female finishing chute in order of finish until you are handed a "place" stick. Take the stick to the appropriate scorer's table at run headquarters. Give your name, age and stick to the scorer. PLEASE TURN YOUR STICKS IN IMMEDIATELY SO AWARDS CAN BE ASSIGNED. Run officials have the authority to disqualify from receiving awards runners who leave headquarters without submitting place sticks.
