**COURSE** The course is paved except for the first and final 550 yards on the track. Measured according to TAC standards, the course is moderately flat with hills at 1 1/2 and 4 1/2 miles.

ENTRY FEE The entry fee is \$6 before November 10. After that date, including race day, the fee is \$8. All entrants will receive a colorful long-sleeve t-shirt. Entry fee is not refundable. Race day registration begins at 8 am.


H. W. Harris instituted the Run For The Third in 1978. He was Chairman of the Board of Third National Bank and a long-time supporter of area running and walking.

Minutes from the Annual Meeting of the Columbia Track Club
October 17, 1990

President Joe Marks called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

The 1991 race schedule was discussed. Comments included:

- Steve Stonecipher-Fisher is coordinating C.T.C.'s role in two upcoming cross-country meets. He is looking for more runners.
- Rob Spier may have to change the date of the 100 mile walk championship to coordinate the track, locker room facilities, etc.
- The C.T.C. will help University Hospital with the Jingle Bell Run. In return the hospital will make a donation to the Scholarship Fund.
- Another biathlon is being considered for the spring, possibly in May.

The Heart of Missouri Biathlon wa a fantastic success! No problems occurred(and it was our first biathlon and our first joint venture with the Columbia Bike Club). We made \$113.78 on the race. One hundred dollars will be donated to the Ross Brownson Fund. Forty-nine people finished the race. Linda Price was the only C.T.C. volunteer to work during the race. The rest of the course was manned by Columbia Bicycle Club members and they did a fantastic job.

Door prizes were awarded. The lucky winners received polypropylene running gloves.

Anne Kaylen presented the treasurer's report. We ended the year with almost \$2000 than we had last September. The balance is about \$5000. This is a healthy amount to have. It allows us to put on some big events like the St. Patrick's Day Race and the Human Race and keep our expenses covered until sponsors submit their contributions.

Alkn Tom the, head of the Search Committee for new board members, reported that all old members whose terms expired this year agreed to be considered for re-election. Roger Turnbough was added as a new member. Rob Spier resigned as a board member.

#### Other business:

- Joe Marks raised the issue of having more meetings. It was decided to add more only if a need arose.
- Anne Kaylen suggested having pasta parties before big races. We will work with the Bicycle Club and possibly do some joint ventures. The C.T.C. will sponsor a pasta party before the Apple Cup Race if the C.B.C will sponsor one before the Human Race.
- Mike Little began a discussion of race course alternatives.

The Steve Helmick Race course is very busy. However nothing can be done to change it.

According to the Dept. of Conservation the Katy trail cannot be closed off for races. It is not comfortably wide enough to allow passage for walkers, bikers and racers going in two directions at once. Races will have to start early and probably go point to point.

- We discussed changing race fees to include reduced rates for seniors, families, etc. The only complaints regarding fees have been about the Show- Me-State Games road race(\$15). A consensus was reached. Fees will remain as they are.
- The C.T.C. has a policy that if a group approaches us asking for help to put on a race, they must contribute some money to us.
- The chronomix does not work. It will be fixed.
- Our membership in the Road Runners Club of America was dropped because they raised their fees to \$1 per person without increasing their benefits.
