The few, the proud ...

... the attendees of the CTC annual meeting

When you can count the number of people at your annual meeting on two hands (plus one toe), it doesn't say much for participatory democracy. But meet we did, Oct. 28 at the public library.

The bulk of our time was spent working out a 1997 schedule. A few days after the annual meeting, the CTC board met and tied up some of the loose ends on the schedule and in other areas. You can see the tentative preliminary schedule inside this newsletter. Here are some of the other items discussed and decided:

- ✓ CTC is in the process of working out a written agreement with M.U on the use of the track facility for CTC events and for member use.
- The Big Brothers/Big Sisters Stadium Run has changed its format from a 10-K to a 5-K and 1-mile run. The change was made for two main reasons: to attract more runners and to raise more money for BB/BS. The 5-K will still have the staggered start, running on the streets of Columbia, and the mile run will be on Rock Bridge track.
 - With the requests the track club gets to put on

races for organizations or to provide equipment, we decided NOT to rent our road-race equipment. CTC will provide a policy statement so everyone knows everyone's position entering an event.

- ✓ Any race club, individual or organization will be charged \$25 to place a full-page ad in CTC's newsletter. No exceptions.
- The entry fee for the Heart of America Marathon will rise from \$10 to \$15.
 - Rick Rother, who had asked to step down from the board of directors, was replaced by Dan Kelly.
 - Race directors are needed for the St. Patrick's Day 5-K and other races. Interested parties are urged to contact club president Curt Kempf (446-2878).
- ✓ Joe Duncan made a pitch for the M.U. Track and Field Officials Association. See below.

Here's your chance

- 1 to attend meets at the new M.U. track;
- 2 learn new skills such as raking a sand pit;
- [3] get out of the house for long periods.

CTC members Dick Hessler and Joe Duncan are among the driving forces behind the University of Missouri Track and Field Officials Association. And they are looking for more than a few good men and women.

With M.U.'s new outdoor track up and operating in the spring, there will be a need for dozens of officials to help run meets. No experience or prior training is necessary.

The association is seeking 100 percent redundancy, meaning it hopes to have at least two people for every task. That way, nobody would have to

work at every meet or for the entire duration of any individual meet. Among the roles officials will undertake are as timers, recorders, announcers, field-event judges and many more.
