With 728 entrants, and the expectation of 4-6 inches of snow on the ground for race morning, I decided to show up and make any necessary decisions 30 minutes before the start. What a nice surprise to wake up and find that "chicken little" had struck and we were going to have a very respectable race morning.

Set-up began at 6:30 with Mark Volek, Randy Gay, Curt Kempf, and a number of other generous volunteers showing up to help us complete the finish area and work with packet pick-up. At 7:30 I called our volunteers meeting to order and the Rock Bridge and Hickman teams, the Nikken team, and a number of individuals took their race assignments. So far, pretty smooth sailing for what could have been a difficult event.

8 a.m. came and we moved to the 10th street starting area. I looked over the participants and felt that maybe 250 had shown up. (Final race tally was 545 finishers! Maybe that's why I've never won anything by guessing how many beans are in the jar!? With "runners set" and "go," they were on their way. In the men's race we had a repeat winner from last year in Randy Starr, and in the women's race his wife, Sue Starr, finished first! Pretty good running for the Jeff City couple. Two very nice people; but I'm going to encourage Columbia to get a little more competitive!

Special **Thanks** to Columbia Regional Hospital for their support, both financial and otherwise, for this event. They fund our youth summer track program with this one event, and it is very much appreciated. Also, KPLA radio again worked with us to provide race coverage, the sound system, and food and drink at the finish/awards area. I'd finally like to thank coaches Rick Baer (Rock Bridge) and Steve Kissane (Hickman) for gathering volunteers to work this event. Without volunteers none of our events could be held.

Looking Back

March 9, 1974 One Mile Run: 1. Dennis Stewart 4:24. . . . 10. Don Lewis 5:11, 11. Don Granberg 5:19, 12. Whitney Hicks 5:21, 13. Turk Storvick, 45, 5:32, and 16 others.

March 23, 1974 The Event in Which We Learned to Never Cancel a CTC Event: A Two-Person Six Mile Relay was scheduled for Hickman track. It was apparent that because of a crippling six inch snowstorm we had to cancel and we did. However, at the scheduled 2:00pm start I got a phone call from Dennis Stewart, in from Higginsville. He, Dean Neal, Rex Frazer, in from Ft. Wood, and Tom Kilburn were at the track wondering where everyone was. These incorrigible runners were determined to run. So they did—indoors. The only indoor facility they could fine was the balcony of the old Columbia College gym. They ran 75 laps around that balcony, completing 3 miles (they think).

1. Stewart 17:15, 2. Kilburn 18:10, 3. Neal and Frazer 19:08. CTC has never canceled an event since then.

The next day we did 5 laps on the old Cosmos Park .6 mile loop: 1. Kilburn 15:52, 2. Mike Chippendale 16:52, . . .4. Hicks 18:48. . .6. Joe Duncan 20:07. Dave Leuthold walked in 28:09 and Rob Spier in 31:42.

March 21, 1974 In a historic Executive Committee meeting it was decided to have an age group development program in the summer. The format: Six Wednesday evenings at Hickman track with 440, 880, mile, 2 or 3 mile runs, and a mile walk with emphasis on development and participation. This program continues to this day, virtually unchanged, and probably has been the most significant thing we have done. The CTC Colts program came from this and hundreds of youngsters have been involved with many of them going on to compete on the high school and college level. At those first 1974 Wednesday evenings, the Hessler family was present and heavily involved. Eight year old Amy was there and has never left, nor have Mom and Dad!



Two-Person 5 Mile Relay

March 27, 1999

Six teams took advantage of the nearly perfect weather and participated in this year's Two-Person Relay. The race was held on Saturday March 27 at the Hickman High School Track.

Aaron Aaker and Jeff Brault were the winning team with a record time of 23:51. The previous record was 24:36 set by Dick and Pete Hessler in 1996. Aaron and Jeff averaged just over 71 seconds for each 400 meter lap. That's moving along at a pretty good clip and is a pace that will challenge future participants. James Jurgenson and Dan Wright came in second with a time of 29:12. The rest of the teams were closely matched with Amy and Gary Gundy squeaking out third place in a friendly competition.

The Two-Person Relay has a unique format where the two team members alternate running every 400 meters through a total distance of 8K. Participants received gift certificates to the Chesapeake Bagel Bakery.





A few years ago I took an interest in running and have been hooked ever since. It has been my hope for some time now to be able to use my God given ability and fitness to promote a good cause and that opportunity has arrived. I have joined up with the Leukemia Society's "Team in Training" and pledged to run a marathon in San Diego on May 23, 1999. You might be wondering why I am doing this. There are two reasons and they are of flesh and blood. When I was fifteen years old I lost my cousin Mike to leukemia and was robbed of the chance to really get to know him. Now, I have Keenan, my honor patient, who is currently battling this affliction and I want to give him and others like him the opportunity to reach their potential and not be cut short by a disease that is curable.

Who is Keenan?

Keenan is a brave three-year-old boy from Gravois Mills, MO who was diagnosed with acute lymphocytic leukemia about two years ago. Since that time he has endured surgery, chemotherapy daily every two weeks and a spinal tap every other month. Fortunately, he has entered his last year of treatment. I met Keenan last December and he made quite an impression on me. If I were not told of his struggle I would have never known. He is a bright inquisitive boy, always asking questions and never holds back a smile.

What is the Leukemia Society?

The Leukemia Society is a not-for-profit health organization dedicated to finding a cure for leukemia and its related cancers (lymphoma, multiple myeloma and Hodgkin's disease), and to improve the lives of patients and their families.
